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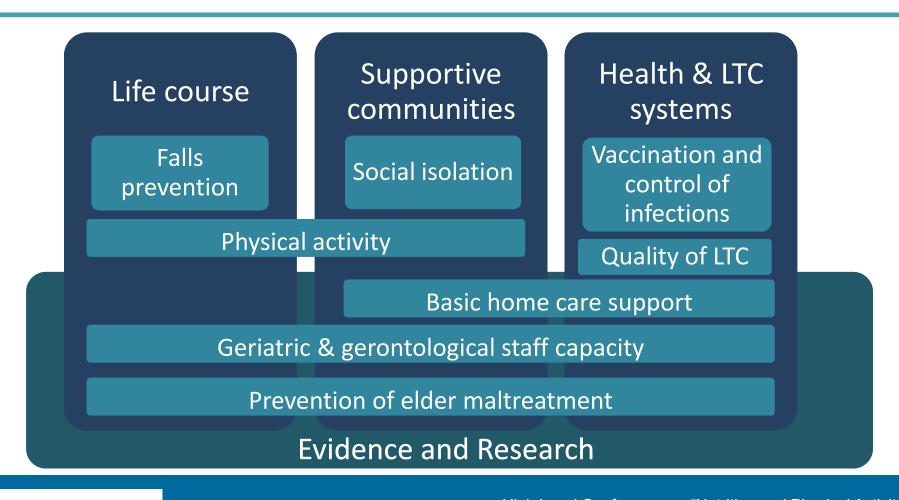

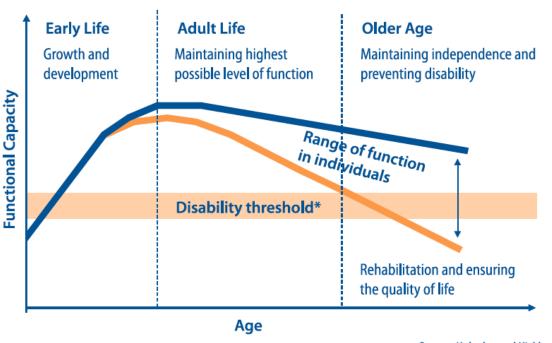

Healthy ageing in a life-course perspective

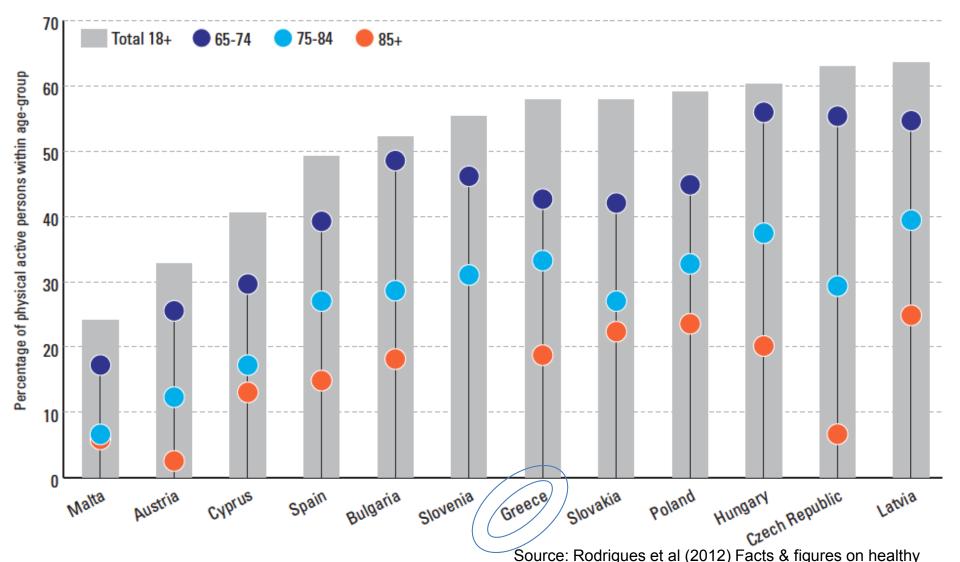
Figure 4. Maintaining functional capacity over the life course

Physical activity (>30 min/day) becomes more challenging in higher age groups



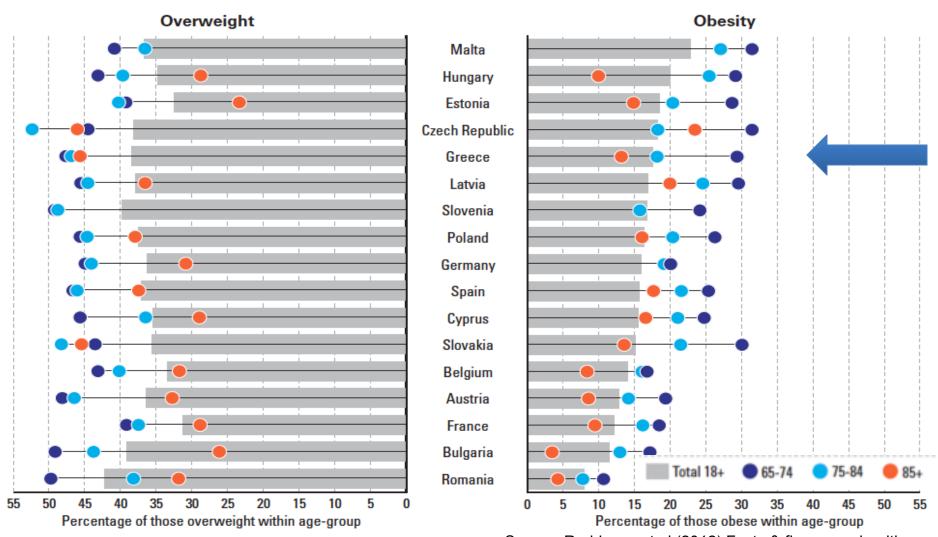

Preventive functions of physical activity in older age groups

- Cardio-respiratory health (coronary heart disease, cardiovascular disease, stroke and hypertension)
- Metabolic health (diabetes and obesity)
- Musculo-skeletal health (bone health, osteoporosis)
- Cancer (breast and colon cancer)
- Functional health and prevention of falls
- Mental health, cognitive functions, self reported QoL
- Delayed need for care in older adults

Links to overweight become more complex for higher age groups

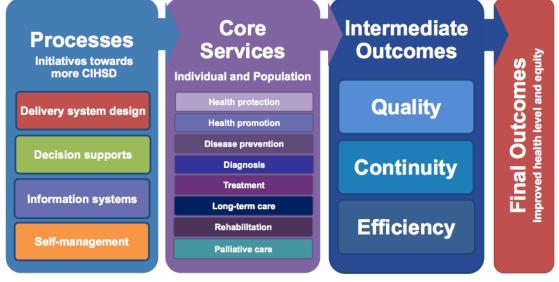

- Quality of long-term care services

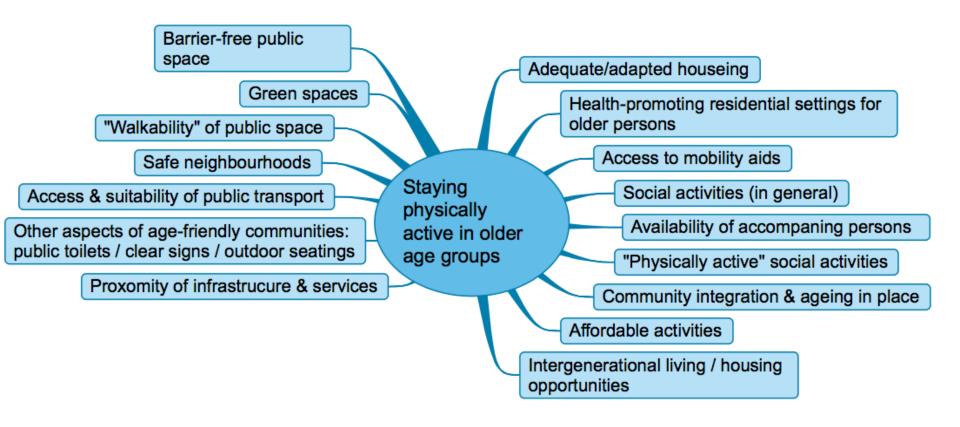


Supportive environments
